Interview

Meeting with the parent/guardian helps us to determine the appropriate placement of the child in one of our programs. During the interview, typically one hour, we give you an in-depth overview of our approach to early childhood education and an opportunity to discuss your questions about Waldorf Education.

Financial Aid

We are able to offer some financial assistance with tuition. Please call to request more information about this program.

Acceptance

Admission decisions will be mailed by March 15, 2012. You must return the commitment form, \$200 tuition deposit and \$500 new student fee by March 26, 2012.

Tuition Agreement

Our Admissions Director will schedule an appointment with you to sign your tuition agreement, make payment arrangements, and fill out medical and authorization forms. Class assignments will be mailed by June 1, 2012. Your child's teacher will contact you to gather more information about your child before the start of school.
