



## Open Call for Seattle – Pacific Northwest Artists

This spring we will engage our community in a unique, inspiring event and are extending an open call for artistic contributors. Using a design based on the former SWS tree logo and working with Pacific Studio in Ballard, sculptures are available for artists to embellish as they see fit. The trees will be on display at a Seattle gallery in late April and will be auctioned off online the week of May 3 – May 7, 2010.

The trees will measure about 17" square and will be made of a reinforced plaster material.

Finished trees will be due back to SWS by mid-April, 2010.

Seattle Waldorf is the oldest Waldorf school in Washington state and the only one to offer a pre-kindergarten through grade twelve curriculum. We have a population of 362 students of all ages. Our campus spans three locations in the greater Seattle area and we will celebrate 30 years of operations next year.
