After-School Caregiver

Position Starts: February 1, 2012

Responsible to: Head of Pedagogy

Hours: Grade School Campus, 3:00 pm to 6:00 pm each school day.

Position Description: The After-School Caregiver supervises grade school students (grades one through five) after school, consisting of a free playtime, snack, and time for activities. The caregiver is responsible for preparing the space, leading the children through the rhythm of the program, and cleaning the site at the end of the day, as well as supplies purchase within a defined budget.

In achieving these outcomes, the instructor may not utilize any method inconsistent with Waldorf education methods as accepted by SWS, nor violate any SWS policy.

Qualifications:

- Warm, caring, disciplined way with children and adults
- Strong communication, organization, and time-management skills
- Dependability and self-confident
- Able to ask for help when need arises
- High school diploma or equivalent; child development education or work experience.
- Sound understanding of and ability to articulate Waldorf education, or willingness to learn
- Able to work out-of-doors in all weather
- Able, unassisted, to walk, talk, hear, stand, see, sit and negotiate stairs
