About the Position

This .5FTE position has a flexible schedule and the potential for growth with additional teaching or educational support for students. The person filling this position will be responsible for helping our students through the full cycle college admission process, from determining where to apply, to navigating the application process, to determining best fit. This position requires exceptional written and verbal communication, organizational, and problem-solving skills. Attention to detail, follow-through, and the ability to meet deadlines are a must. Previous experience in college admission or high school college counseling preferred. Familiarity with Waldorf education is a plus.
