About the Position

Seattle Waldorf High School is now accepting applications for a professional musician to teach instrumental ensembles. Classes are on Tuesday and Thursday, 1:30–3:30 p.m. during the school year. There are beginning and intermediate/advanced-level groups with varieties of instrumentation. Guitar skills are essential, piano/bass facility is needed, and arranging skills, along with positive coaching are necessary to prepare the ensembles for concerts. The repertoire can be in any idiom from jazz to rock. The music department also offers classical string orchestra, choir, and African/Cuban/Brazilian percussion ensembles. Formal music training required; graduate degree and/or Waldorf certification preferred.
