

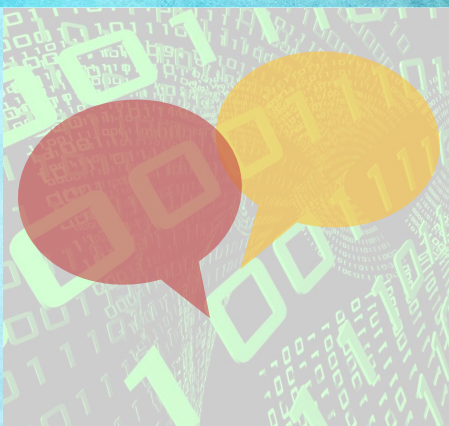
COMMUNITY CONVERSATION
