Substitute teachers are responsible for presenting an established lesson plan and for classroom management. Substitute teachers may be scheduled ahead of time, or, if available, may be called on the day needed for last-minute substitution. Bachelor's degree required; graduate degree and knowledge of Waldorf Education preferred.
